In high school times I took part in BELAMUN – Belarusian Model UN, working on the problem of the human impact of cluster munitions. Graduated from Winter Academy of UNESCO clubs, I was the first chairman of UNESCO club "Adradzhenne" (Rebirth). Nowadays I am a volunteer of the international organization Caritas. I work with lots of teenagers, help them to improve their communicative skills, realise their creative potential, find themselves in complicated situations.

I would like to suggest the creation of a thematic entertainment and educational club, which could host meetings of young people, topical discussions, the realisation of creative potential through literary evenings, performances by young musicians of various genres. In the future, I would like to open my own farm and create an environmental training centre for the local population on its basis.



PREPARE Gathering in 2011. In 2011 more than 150 participants from about 20 European countries gathered in Zlatibor, Republic of Serbia. During the gathering June 29 - July 2, 2011, the conference "Access EU with Integrated Rural Development" took place and a local tour to ethno-complex was organised. PREPARE travelling workshops was organised on the following themes: Rural development initiatives in the Vojvodina region, Rural development initiatives in South-western Serbia region, Rural development initiatives in Central Serbia region, Rural development initiatives in the Raska region.

INTRODUCING OUR MEMBERS - Network for Rural Development of Montenegro

The network was founded by 11 NGOs in 2012 and currently consists of 22 rural development NGOs. The network has already developed a good relationship with all the local governments in Montenegro, as well as the majority of ministries, of which the most productive is the collaboration with the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, with which it has signed an agreement on cooperation and mutual support. MNRD is one of the network initiators and founders of the Balkan Network for Rural Development (BNRD). Since its founding MNRD, in addition to the day-to-day work, had several activities such as: organisation of the international conference "The role of civil society in rural development of the Western Balkan" (2012); establishment and continuous work on the "Rural Portal"; coorganisation of "Traveling workshops Montenegro - Macedonia -Serbia" (2014); organisation of the international conference "The role of family agriculture in the development of rural areas" (2014). MNRD has also participated in all major domestic, regional and international events that have been organised since its founding.
